MOTION TO REHEAR

COURT INFORMATION

TRAFFIC/CRIMINAL CASES

If convicted by the General District Court, you have the right to file a motion to reopen your case within <u>60 calendar days</u> after your trial date. You must file your motion in person, or in writing if you live **more** than <u>50 miles</u> from the court. Motions to reopen will be granted <u>only upon a showing of good cause</u>.

Monday through Thursday: Motions must be filed no later than 11:00 am and will be heard on the 1:30 pm docket the same day.

Friday: Motions must be filed no later than 10:00 am and will be heard on the 11:00 am docket the same day.

If you file a motion to rehear, a General District Court Judge will decide if there is good cause to reopen your case and then handle it accordingly if reopened.
