The 2015 Road World Championships begin Saturday, September 19 and end Sunday, September 27. Minimal disruption is anticipated during the week leading up to the race, allowing regular access and parking for the public. However, access to the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals buildings will be impaired for the duration of the event. Please be advised that heavier traffic volumes and course road closures will occur daily in the Downtown Accessibility Area, which is bounded on the north by Broad Street, on the east by Governor Street, on the south by Main Street, and on the west by 2nd Street. The Supreme Court and Court of Appeals buildings are centered in the Downtown Accessibility Area. During course road closure times, access to this area is from the south, where vehicular crossing points will allow for controlled travel across Main Street at 6th Street, 7th Street, 8th Street and 9th Street. Drivers entering the Downtown Accessibility Area during race times should plan to do so from the south via northbound 7th or 9th Streets. Drivers leaving the area should plan to do so to the south via southbound 6th or 8th Streets. Marshall Street will be converted to two-way travel between 5th Street and 7th Street.
