



Accessing Case Filings and Dispositions Data for the District and Circuit Courts of Virginia on the Judicial System's Website

Quick Reference Guide

Case filings and dispositions data are available for the district courts and circuit courts of Virginia on the Virginia Judicial System's website.

Follow the steps 1-5 below to access the data **OR** Click [here](#) and then follow steps 4 and 5.

1. Go to <https://vacourts.gov>. Locate the Search field in the upper right corner.
2. Click to place your cursor in the space provided. Do not click the magnifying glass icon.
3. Select Caseload Statistical Information (CSI) from the list of options displayed. This will route you to the Court Performance & Statistical Services Division home page.
4. Under **Caseload Statistical Information (CSI)**, select the level of court (General District Court, Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court or Circuit Court) for which you want to view data.
5. If needed, expand the **Case Filings or Case Dispositions** accordion using the arrow on the far right end of the heading. The accordions display 2 options:
 - **View Daily Report.** Select this option to access the Power BI reports. These reports refresh daily.
 - **Download Monthly Report.** Select this option to view the static number of cases filed or disposed during each month of the prior and current calendar year. This report is updated monthly.

Navigating Power BI Case Filings and Dispositions Reports

Quick Reference Guide

Expand or Hide Case Type Details:

Use the plus (+) icon to show case type details. Use the minus (-) icon to hide case type details.

Year Selection: Select the year for which you want to view data. The report will compare the year selected to the prior year.

Locale or District/Circuit Selection:

Select dropdown arrow to display a list of localities or district/circuit numbers from which to choose. Click the locale name or district/circuit number to filter the data based on the selection made.

Filter: Select a division and or case type by which to filter report data. To make multiple selections, press control (Ctrl) on your keyboard and select the division(s) or case type(s) you want to view.

Report Pages: Use these back and forward arrows to move through the report pages. Filings reports and Dispositions reports provide data on three levels (locale, district or circuit, and state) and by Years and Months. The data reported is described on the Public Help page, which is the first page of each report. Pages 2-3 provide data by locale, pages 4-5 provide data by district, and pages 6-8 provide statewide data.



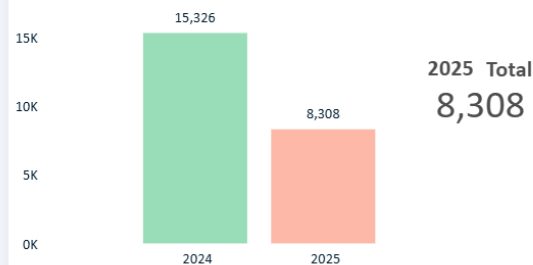

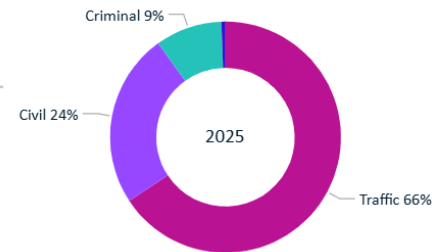

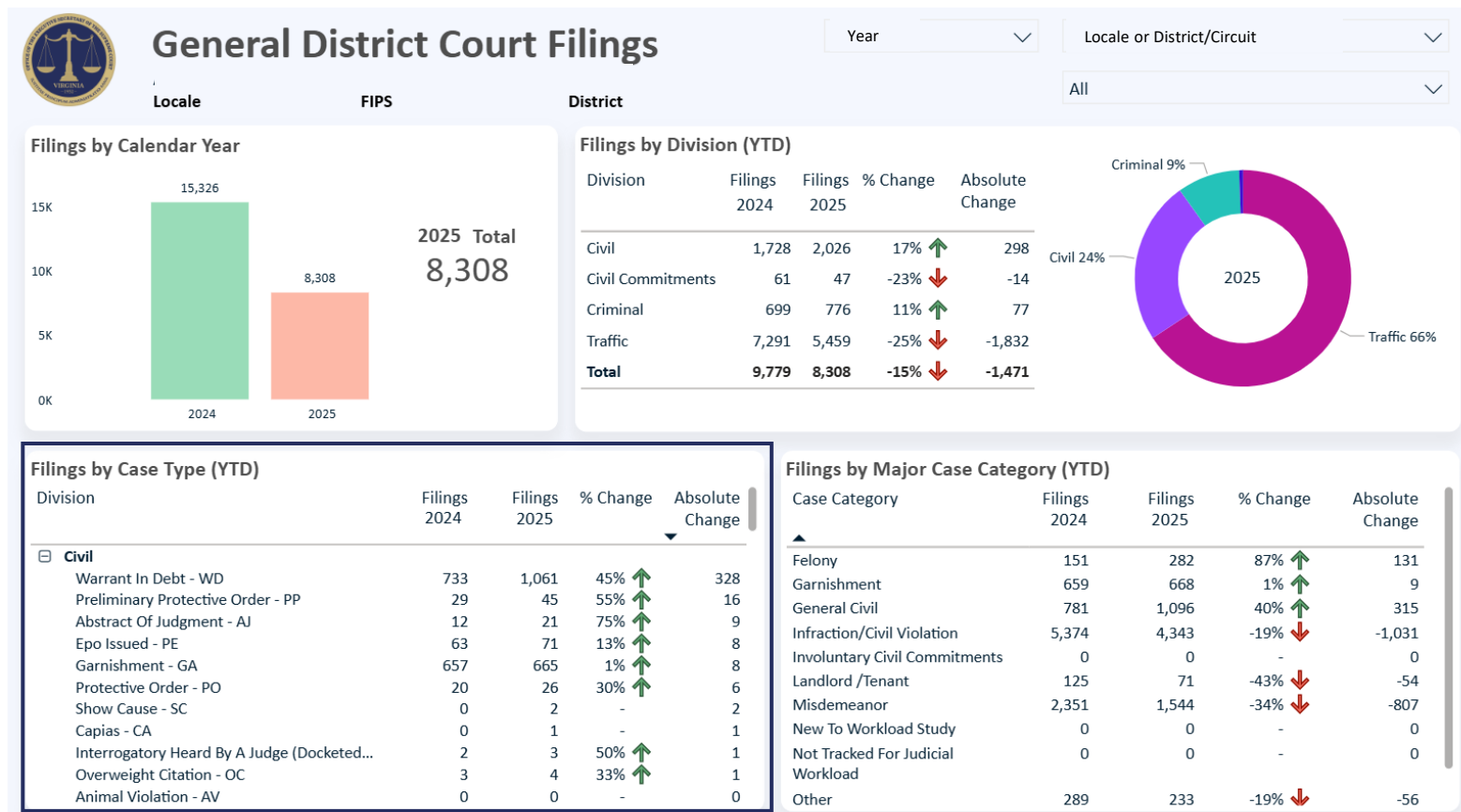


Navigating Power BI Case Filings and Dispositions Reports

Quick Reference Guide

To print case filings and dispositions reports using the Power BI web reports, you will need to use the print option in your web browser.

When printing, note that only the data shown on the screen will print. This means that visuals with a scroll bar, like the one highlighted below, will not print the divisions and case types that are below the last one shown (e.g., Animal Violation-AV).
