## Supreme Court of Virginia Statistical Review 2017

**Introduction** In 2017, there were 1,782 petitions filed and 1,697 cases decided in the Supreme Court of Virginia (SCV). Although there has been a downward trend during the past 15 years, there were slight increases between 2008 and 2009 (<1.0%). Between 2013 and 2017, there was a decrease of 13.1% in petitions filed in the SCV, while there was a decrease of 15.1% in cases decided. Despite these decreases between 2013 and 2017, there was an increase (4.1%) in 2015 of petitions filed. In 2017, there was a decrease of 3.8% in peitions filed from last year. Cases decided remained around the same as last year. In previous years' reports, procedural dismissed cases were not included in the number reported in the grand gotal of cases decided. This 2017 report includes procederal dismissed cases in the grand total of cases decided for 2013-2017. Additionally, prodedural dismissed cases are reported separately in Table 1 in the Appeal Petitions section. This caseload statistical review focuses on trends in filings and case types between 2013 and 2017 in the SCV.

Supreme Court Petitions Filed and Decided 2013-2017



Cases Filed and Decided The table above (Table 1) shows an overview of the case dispositions for the SCV for the past five calendar years, as well as the total petitions filed each of those years. In 2017, the SCV recorded 1,782 petitions filed, 70 less than the 1,852 in 2016 and 268 less than the 2,050 in 2013. There were 1,697 decided cases in 2017, an increase of one or 0.1% from the previous year. In 2017, 6.6% of cases that were decided were granted appeal petitions which decreased 21.1% from 2016. In 2017, 10.4% of cases that were decided were original jurisdiction petitions. Table 2 shows the different SCV case types. The decrease recorded in petitions filed was driven by the decrease in civil. In 2017, there was an increase of 3.2% in criminal petitions. Civil petitions decreased by 31 or 5.4% from 569 in 2016 to 538 in 2017.

## **Case Filings Mix**

Criminal, civil and writ of habeas corpus cases constituted the majority or 87.3% of the petitions filed. The percentage of criminal petitions in 2013 was 42.6%, and this percentage rose in 2017 to 44.9% of total petitions filed. The percentage of civil petitions increased from 26.4% in 2013 to 30.2% in 2017. Writ of habeas corpus cases constituted 16.1% and 12.2% of the overall caseloads in 2013 and 2017, respectively.

Display 2 **Supreme Court Case Types Filed 2013, 2017** 



**Appeal Petitions: Granted** Of the appeal petitions granted (112), civil petitions constituted the majority, 71.4% in 2017. In 2016, there was a decrease in civil granted of 15 (15.8%) from 2016 and an increase of one (1.3%) from 2013. There were 23 granted criminal petitions, a decrease of seven or 23.3% from the 30 granted in 2016.

**Refused** In 2017, there were 1,162 cases refused with the majority (60.9%) being criminal in nature. There were increases in civil and *habeas* appeals, which caused the overall increase of 30 or 2.7% in the total refused appeal petitions from the previous year.

**Original Jurisdiction Petition** In 2017, the total number of original jurisdiction cases decided was 189, which is 15 cases or 7.4% less than 2016, and 125 cases or 39.8% less than 2013. Of the 189 cases, eight or 4.2% were awarded (eight *writ of habeas corpus*).

Motions, Requests, and Filings Table 5 shows filings by type. Notice of appeal constituted 24.4% of the total 1,700 filings in 2017. IFP Affidavit was 21.0% of the total and response or reply to a motion or objection was 8.1%. Motions and requests filed included appointment of counsel/public defender and extension of time among various other categories. In 2017, there were 1,369 motions and requests filed in the SCV which was an increase of 51 or 3.6% from 2016.
